We are making an effort to get a firm count of how many students are coming by July 1st so we can do a better job at having the right amount of food and the proper shirt sizes for all attending. We never turn anyone away, but if your form and deposit are not on time, we cannot guarantee a shirt in the correct size for your student(s).

We will be leaving from the Clearfield NXT GEN Center at 3:30 PM on Sunday and arriving at Little Mahoning Bible Camp at approximately 4:45 PM. Dinner will be provided on Sunday. Registration of students will begin at The Crossroad at 3:00 PM, so please do your best to be there early so your student(s) can get registered. If you are coming from The Wreck Center in Houtzdale, please meet there by 2:30 PM. You will either be driven to the NXT GEN Center or straight to the camp. We will be departing Little Mahoning Bible Camp by 1:30 PM on Friday and will be arriving back at The Clearfield NXT GEN Center by approximately 3:00 PM. *Please pick your student(s) up at the NEX GEN Center at 3:00 PM. If your student was dropped off at The Wreck Center, please pick them up at 3:30 PM.* If you are unable to pick up your student(s) and have made other arrangements, please send a note with your student(s) stating who will be taking them home. Students will contact you as they leave camp to provide an accurate arrival time at each youth center.

Cell Phone Policy

PARENTS/GUARDIANS: PLEASE READ

In recent years, it has become increasingly difficult to separate students from their mobile devices. While we understand the convenience of having a single device that can play music, take pictures, record videos, and make phone calls/send messages, those same devices become problematic when they are used to view inappropriate content on the internet, create and sustain drama amongst students at camp, and constantly use social media outlets during message and instructional times. Little Mahoning Bible Camp does not offer Wi-Fi, but students with unlimited Data and a cell signal have unfettered access to the internet and can create mobile hotspots for others to use.

With this in mind, our aim is not to single anyone out but to help the students to unplug for the week. We will be requesting that students limit their cell phone use to designated times, and if any individual cannot abide by these requests, we reserve the right to take their phone away. This is not something we like to do, but in consideration of the safety and enjoyment of the whole camp, we will do what is necessary while striving to keep the dignity of any individual involved.

You can help us have a successful summer camp by having a conversation with your student(s) about this policy. We appreciate your partnership with us as we do our best to share the love of Jesus Christ with your student(s) in an environment free of distraction.

2019 Summer Teen Camp Dress Code:

Dress needs to be modest relative to the conditions of summer camp. We ask that you follow the dress code to avoid unneeded distraction.

Boys: Please keep your shirts on and your pants or shorts up! A shirt is required for swimming...and please, no spandex!

Girls: All tank top straps need to be as wide as two fingers held together. No midriff shirts or low-cut shirts will be permitted. One piece swim suits are allowed, or a non-white t-shirt needs to be worn over any two-piece. Spandex pants, shorts, or shirts are not permitted. Shorts and skirts should be long enough to keep you covered...no if's, and's, or...you know.
